(a blend of trebbiano toscano and malvasia del Chianti, with a little San Colombano): Amber-gold. A whiff of volatile acidity adds pungency and lift to the orange jam, caramel and almond aromas. Very sweet, round and smooth, with lively flavors of spicy baked apple and apricot complicated by notes of marzipan and white chocolate. Finishes bright and juicy, with a lingering note of hazelnut. Get a load of these numbers: 230 g/l residual sugar and 6.5 g/l total acidity. From fruit that was air-dried for four months; aged in *caratelli* for seven years.
